# Dine-a-round

La Bodeguita, 3138 Coral Way, Miami

Two weeks after Cinco de Mayo, our May Dine-a-round transforms us to the namesake of where the Mojito was invented, and Ernest Hemingway's favorite hangout and dining spot in Old Havana, Cuba: La Bodeguita Del Medio. Having been at this island in the sun's original charismatic restaurant on a recent trip to the island 90 miles from Key West, the ambience of La Bodeguita Miami certainly feels authentic, with a variety of Cuban dishes, nostalgic for those whose families hail from Cuba and exciting for those who wish to share in the atmosphere and international flair of this local find just east of Coral Gables. Hostess Lourdes and proprietor Joseph Maya are anxious to welcome us for a fun evening of cultural food and music, including the sounds of the Buenavista Social Club.

Choice of **appetizers**: *Tamal en hoja* (corn tamale made Cuban style with onion and garlic sauce); *croquetas de jamón y pollo con mariquitas* (ham & chicken croquettes with chips); *empanadas de chorizo* (empanadas filled with Spanish sausage). Salad/Ensaladas: *lechuga, tomates y pepinos en aderezo de vinagre balsámico* (house salad, lettuce, tomatoes, cucumbers with vinaigrette dressing).

**House specialties**: *todos los platos están servidos con 2 acompañantes: arroz blanco jasmín, moros o maduros* (entrees are served with your choice of 2 side orders: jasmine white rice, moros or fried plantains). Choice of Entrée: *masas de puerco fritas con salsa criolla de cebollas y ajo asado* (crispy and tender fried pork chunks with onions and roasted garlic sauce); *pechuga de pollo a la parrilla* (grilled chicken breast); *filete de tilapia a la parrilla* (grilled tilapia served with lemon butter sauce).

Choice of **dessert**: *flan de leche* (custard with cream) or *arroz con leche* (rice pudding).

**Beverage**: choice of one glass of white or red wine or Mojito; coffee included.

As usual, we look forward to a wonderful meal, turnout, and the camaraderie which continues to draw so many friends and new members to our Dine-a-rounds. Reservations will be made upon receipt of your check on a first-reserved, first-served basis in date order.
